For any kind of study, I prefer face to face. And in WSU, summer courses are all online.

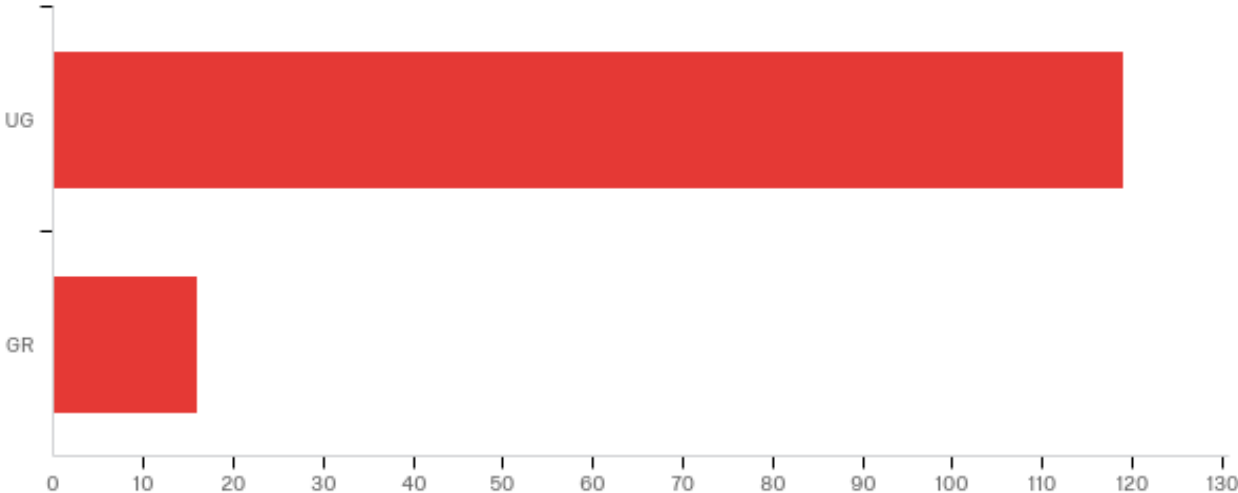
I wish more options were given for online goal areas especially goal 3. Also, goal 3 lab classes are very hard to take with art classes because art classes are 3 hours and run into lab times.

Do you have to pay for completely online courses in the summer?

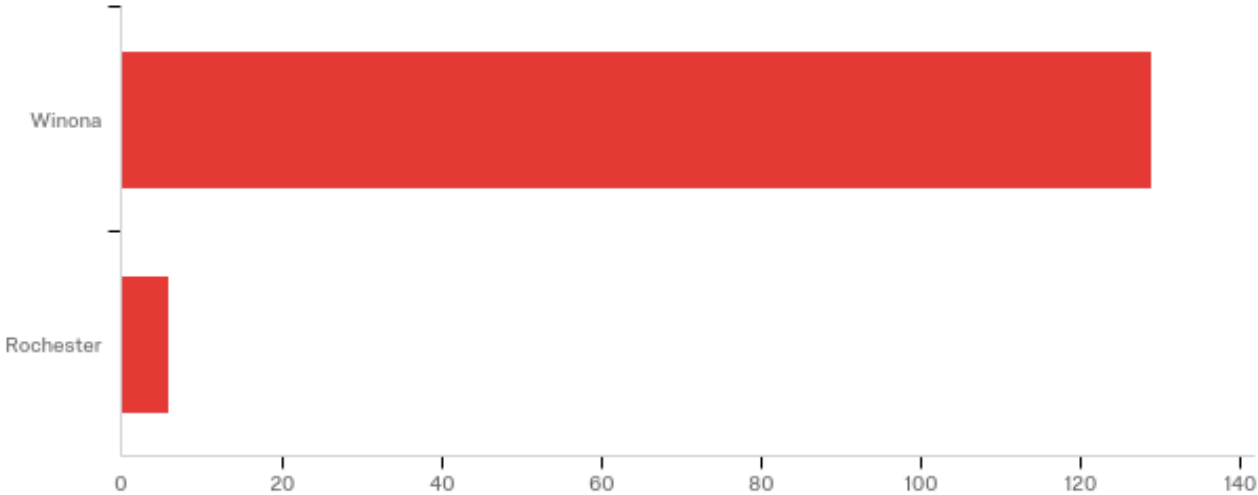

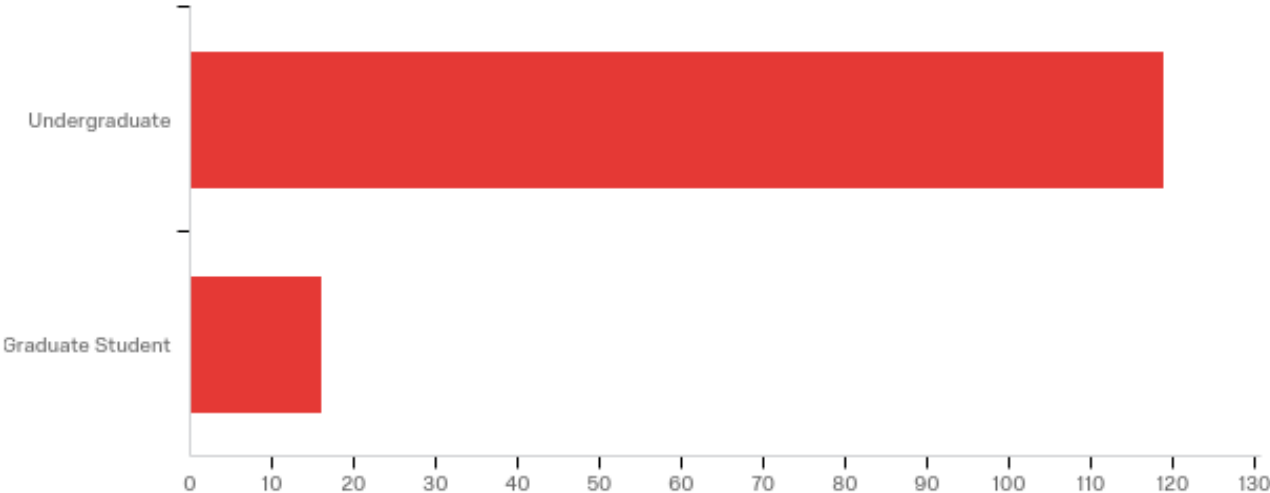

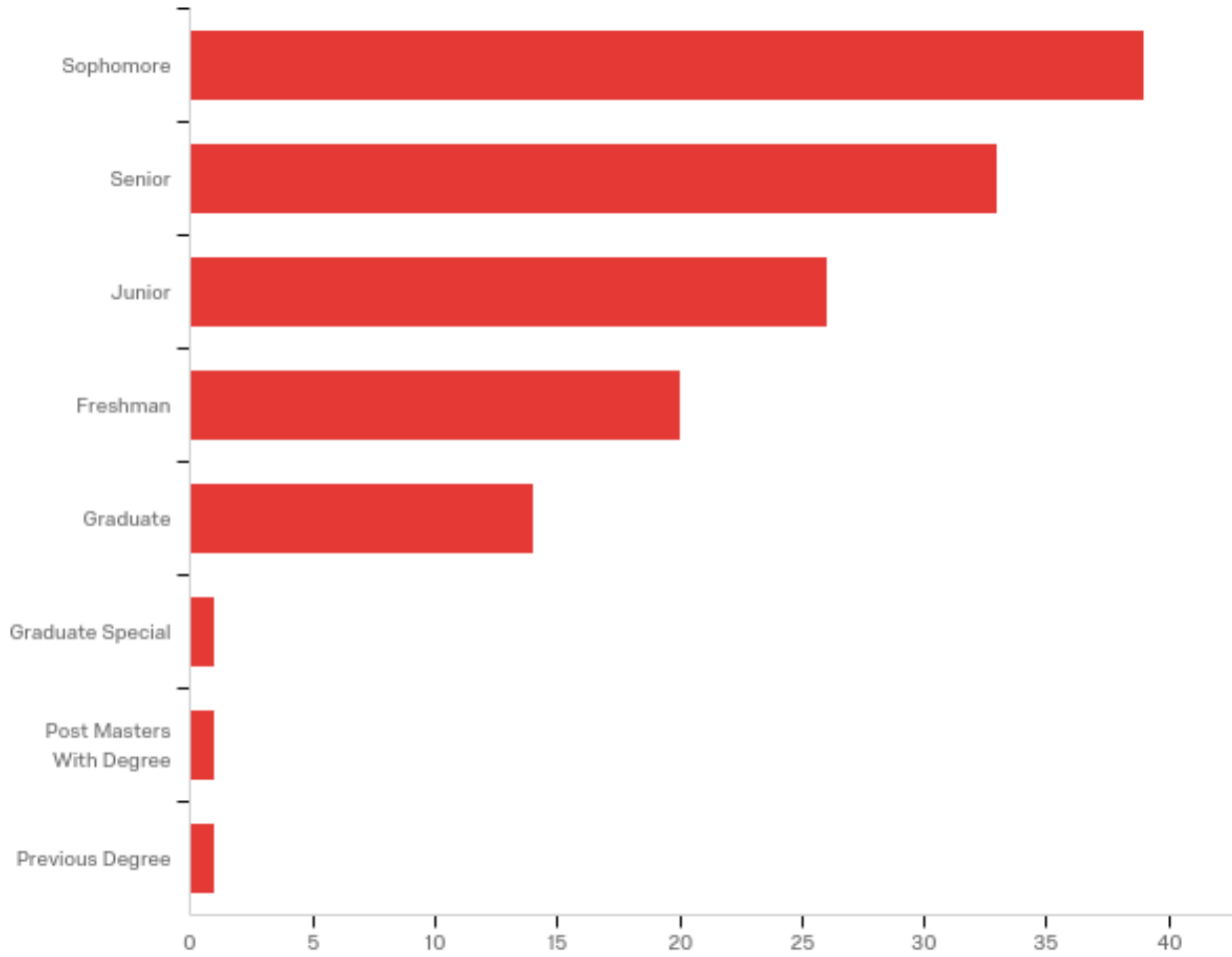
