It can be frustrating when certain classes required for my major are ONLY offered in the summer

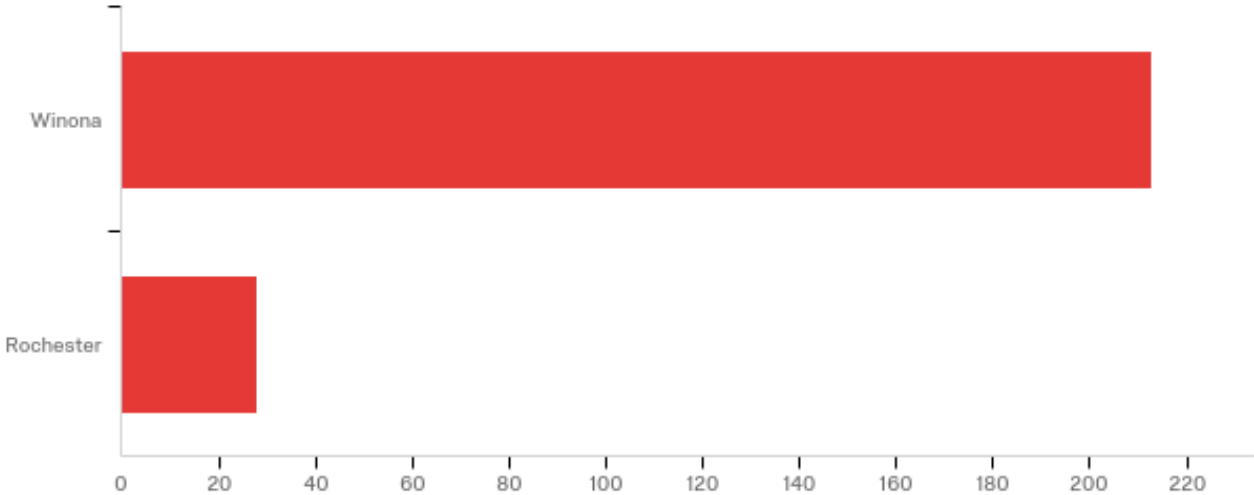
I wish there were more options for online classes during the summer in the HERS department.

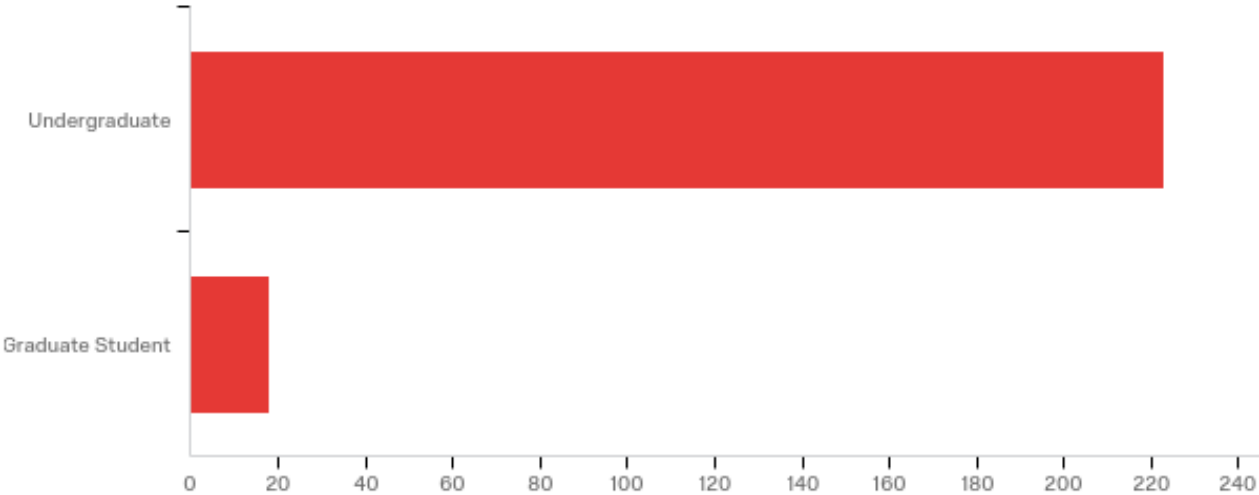
