Policy for Undergraduate Student Research and Creative Project Grants

**PURPOSE:** To encourage and support active, faculty-mentored undergraduate student research and creative projects, Winona State University will provide financial grants to eligible undergraduate students selected by a review process.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

- a) Eligible applicants full-time undergraduate students who have completed a minimum of 60 semester hour credits at time of application
- b) Eligible applicants a university faculty or staff member must sponsor and supervise the student's research or creative project
- c) Eligibility a student is eligible to receive funding to participate in one research or creative project during his or her undergraduate academic career
- d) Maximum award the maximum grant award is \$600, although the sub-committee of the Deans' Council may determine to award less than the maximum amount
- e) Committee -- the review process will be conducted by a sub-committee of the Deans' Council
