
- Chair Hossain: Think diverse information brings a lot of opportunity. More outreach we have the more opportunities
- Senator Peil: idea came from a project I worked on last year. Presented this to the VP about a month ago. To better provide a diverse landscape on campus
- Senator Palmerton: Really good idea, wondering what framework includes, will you have a list of criteria?
 - Senator Peil: We would start with a checklist and making sure the hire process at a
 national and statewide level but also diverse level. Next step would be to work on that list
 so that everything is fair but also more diverse as well.
- Senator Palmerton: Think having a diverse set of people would really benefit our university
- Senator Galvin: Want to caution that we don't just hire diversity just for diversity sake. I agree we should hire more people of color but don't think that should be the sole purpose. Look at their qualifications and not just their skin color
- Senator Haugen: Isn't there the potential that hiring solely for diversity hire? Doesn't that solely discredit this? I hold our enduring hope that all men are created equal and must be treated equally throughout the law. If we are setting a precedent that winona state hires solely on race, doesn't that completely discredit what we are doing. Worried that two candidates that are both qualified one white and one of color that based on something like this the diversity one would be hired.
- Senator Carman: what is the currently the hire process look like for something like this/
 - President Janz: Lorrie actually does have a checklist and there is specific language regarding hiring. We do have a hiring process currently for hiring on campus. Which probably isn't enough but would be happy to change that.
 - O Vp McDowell: The question is when we put out calls and people apply, what would attract a person of color, women, a veteran, international student to apply. Applied to this job and it was beautiful. I would not have come to winona state if she didn't tell me to come and apply. We aren't an exotic place like Florida or california. Many people have to be invited to take that opportunity. I see this as an opportunity to know how and where we should advertise, etc. Want the person who is the best fit for the job. We have had small polls and some polls that are not diverse apply for jobs. This would help.
- Chair Bainbridge: Think this is a good idea. Professors with diverse backgrounds help when explaining some things. Maybe we need to revamp the last two clauses. Add in advertising as well as an equal hiring process.

- Senator Wright: It's not that we are having a process based on the color of their skin or background but building the poll of candidates.
- Senator Peil: Means getting a diverse pool of candidates. Just to name a few that this goes into. Made this project for black students, and think it's important to focus on one diverse group at a time. Explore opportunities, meet the needs for diverse groups on campus, and career development of black students and faculty. Professionalism opportunity. Anyone who wants to read this, send me a message. In the process of presenting this to a lot of people on campus.
- Senator Minich: Think this is great. Wondering what the big picture of this idea is, where would this be going and steps look like after this?
 - o Chair Hossain: will answer to you after this meeting
- Senator Schulz: do think it is important to clarify that this process stays in looking and expanding the pool but doesn't interfere with the hiring process itself
- Director Herman: If there were two candidates, the hirer will choose the stronger candidate. Having a checklist for why we are hiring one person or the other is needed. If we are making this campus diverse, think we do whatever we need to
- Senator Crass: talking about work study or professor?
 - All positions on campus
- Senator Crass: Confused because we are bringing diversity to the campus. Won't help for students, look at how we can get more people to apply
- Chair Bainbridge: TABLED this motion

Whereas, over 1600 students have taken the Green Bandana Pledge,


Whereas, first year and transfer students had the chance to take the pledge during student orientation,
