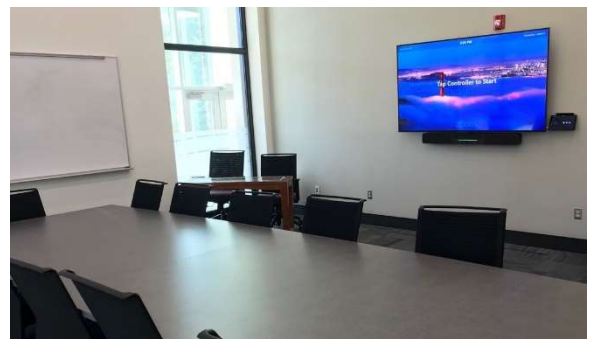

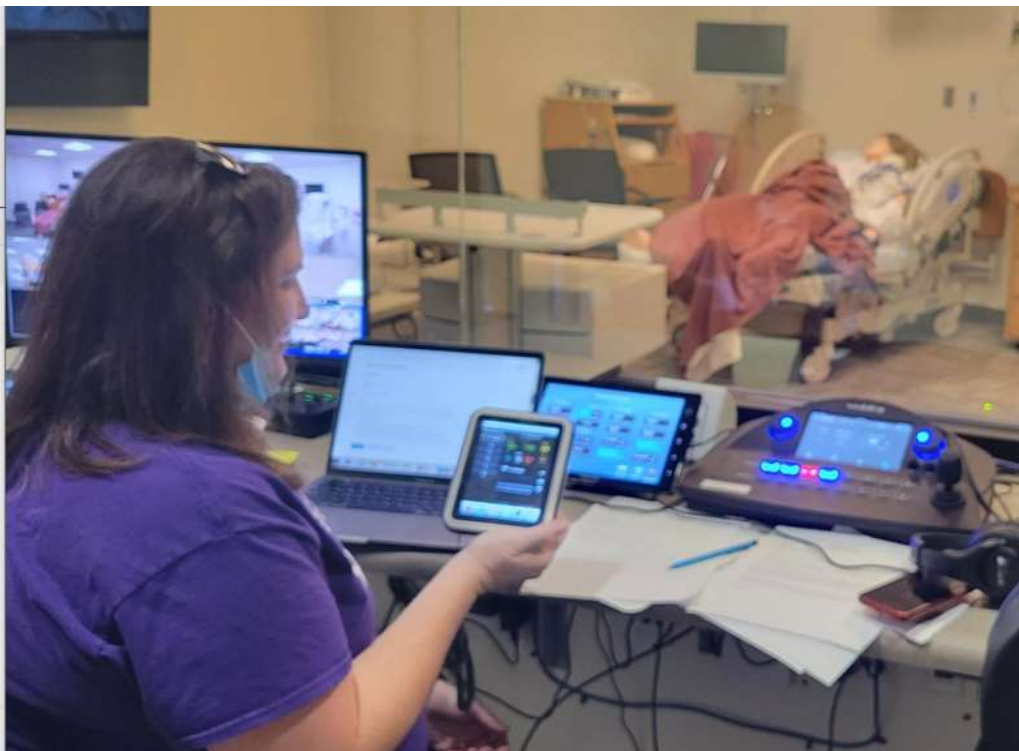

WSU ITS ENSURES NEW NURSING SIMULATION VLAN SUPPORTS LAP INTEGRATION AND ADMINISTRATION

With the anticipated sunsetting of Laerdal’s direct ad-hoc wireless SimLink connectivity, TLT and Infrastructure & Data Services have been working to implement a VLAN specifically for the nursing simulation systems including six manikins, four simpads, four patient/instructor devices, and related equipment. This will allow full connectivity across all lab locations for all devices and simplify updating all systems. The Nursing Department has been successfully utilizing the simulation VLAN in the Winona campus labs for the past week. This is the first phase of a multi-phase project that includes mirroring the VLAN configuration in the WSU simulation spaces in the Science and Technology wing on the RCTC campus. Special thanks to TLT and Infrastructure & Data Services for their work on this project.
